Confirmation Preparation

- Attend Weekly Mass and Mass on Holy Days of Obligation

- Attend Four Confirmation Modules -
Oct 21 at St Mary of the Annuciation, Ladysmith, VA
Nov 4 at Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, Richmond, VA
Jan 27 at St. Paul, Richmond ,VA
Mar 3 at Holy Redeemer, Richmond, VA

They are approximately 3 hours long, from 2 pm - 5 pm, and are located at Churches in the Richmond area.

- Choose a Sponsor
- Provide a Certificate of Baptism
(If baptized in a parish other than the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart)
- Attend a Diocesan Confirmation Retreat
Sunday, Nov. 10 at St. Mary Richmond, VA OR Sunday, Mar. 2 at St. Mary Richmond, VA
- Celebration of the Rite of Confirmation
- Reconciliation
Participation in our April 3, 2019, Community Reconciliation Service at the Cathedral is highly recommended. If this service does not work within your schedule, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is held at the Cathedral church every Saturday at 4:00 pm or by appointment.
- 5-10 hours of Community Service
is strongly encouraged during your preparation for Confirmation. Opportunities will be available through the Cathedral

Choosing Your Sponsor

Your Confirmation Sponsor has an important role in your journey toward Confirmation. A sponsor is someone who supports you in your faith journey, serves as a mentor and role model, and walks with you through this process. Whoever you choose should be a faithful, practicing Catholic who can help lead you in your faith. Baptismal godparents are an option, though not required. If your sponsor cannot attend the ceremony or rehearsal, a parent may stand in their place.

According to Canon law, a sponsor for Confirmation must be:

- A Confirmed Catholic leading a life of faith
- Registered in a Catholic Parish
- Chosen by you, the candidate
- Capable of carrying out the role of a sponsor
- At least 16 years old
- Someone other than the mother, father, or step-parent of the candidate
